





## BEHIND THE SMART WORLD ARTLAB – ARTISTIC STRATEGIES FOR DEALING WITH RESURFACING DATA

Breaches of Western information security thanks to a rise in electronic waste circulation have been particularly pronounced in Ghana, where a certain cadre of citizens has taken to searching out information on Westerners' old hard drives for extortionate purposes.<sup>1</sup>

Since 2010 we as KairUs artist duo have focused on researching topics such as spam, scam and Internet fraud. In August 2014 our research had evolved to the stage that we needed to take a field trip to West Africa, where a considerable number of so called advance fee fraud originates. Rather than hunting down scammers in Internet cafés, we were interested to see which technological affordances or limitations the scammers were faced with in this part of the world. In our initial research we came across reports about an electronic waste dump called Agbogbloshie. In the middle of Ghana's capital Accra, in this toxic wasteland by a lagoon, is where our electronics from developed countries are illegally dumped. Jennifer Gabrys examines in her book *Digital Rubbish*<sup>2</sup> in detail how electronic waste ends up at e-waste dumps such as Agbogbloshie: first they linger in














**Dear Fellow Residents,**
